TASTING NOTES

An expressive and specific reflection of the Westside Paso Robles' vineyards from which it comes, this Pickpocket Grenache offers a focused nose of black cherry, wet earth and patchouli. Touches of toast, caraway, flint, and licorice accompany a palate rich with blackberry and açai berry and an elongated finish.
